

Resolution Declaring Emergency

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Waterville
Pepin County

The Town Board of the Town of Waterville, Pepin County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

An emergency is declared as existing within the Town of Waterville, Pepin County, Wisconsin, for the following reasons: Disaster caused by a combination of Downburst Winds from a Thunderstorm and a Tornado on July 5, 2016.


The period of emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist in the Town of Waterville.

The town board, or its designated agents, has the authority to order whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare, and good order of the Town of Waterville during the emergency, including without limitation the power to bar, restrict, and remove all unnecessary traffic, vehicular or pedestrian, from the local highways.


Any person who violates a lawful order of the town board or its agents made under this emergency declaration shall forfeit not more than \$100 or, in default of payment of the forfeiture, shall be subject to imprisonment for 6 months for each separate offense.

The town clerk shall publish this resolution under s. 60.80, Wis. stats., in a local newspaper. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the town board and the forfeiture penalties shall become effective upon publication.




